He represented our club at every level, including being part of the Under 21 Championship team in 2014. He had an infectious personality and was a great friend to everyone he met. Tournament Structure

This year's competition will feature 12 teams. Teams are organized into 4 groups. Each group contains 3 teams. Every team is guaranteed to play a minimum of 3 matches.

Competition Rules:

All matches will be conducted following the CCC 2 **DUBLIN** regulations tailored for players at Under 14 level. **The tournament is strictly for boys born in 2011 or later.**

- The top 2 teams in each group automatically qualify for quarter finals of the Cup & the bottom team automatically qualifies for the semi finals of Shield Competition
- If two or more teams finish level on points at the end of the group stage, placing will be determined by the result of the head-to-head of both teams.
- If three teams finish on level points at the end of the group stage, placing is determined on points difference, if still level at this point goals scored will be the determining factor.

Adjudication

- For every game, each team and their support will take their position on opposite sides of the playing pitch/area.
- Each team may be asked to provide a linesman.
- For the Semi finals and Finals, in the event of a draw, a penalty shoot, under official GAA guidelines, will be used to determine the outcome.

Match Guidelines

- Each team is to provide an official player list with their squad numbers at registration.
- Players must wear the same numbered jersey throughout competition.
- All games are 12 minutes per half.
- Three-minute halftime breaks.
- Referee can play up to 3 minutes injury time at their discretion, if play is delayed by injury or wasting time.
- · Roll on and roll off substitutes.
- If a player is sent off, he will miss the next match.

Additional Tournament Information

- Each Team will have 2 members go to registration desk no later than 9.30am on the day. There will be a parade for all the teams at 10:10am – you can bring club banners.
 If travelling by bus, please ensure you travel through Portmarnock village as there is a low bridge on the backroad into the club that you cannot pass.
- Pitch allocation will be assigned to you with a map in the welcome pack and goody bag.
- Pitches 1, 2, 3 and 6 will be used for the tournament
- Teams should arrive togged out as dressing room space is limited to 6 dressing rooms.
- First aid services will be available on the day for injuries and medical emergencies
- Lunch of burgers will be provided to players. There will also be water, teas, coffees and sandwiches provided in the main hall fore everyone. Visiting team coaches are responsible for notifying if any dietary allergies of their team members
- Team photo will be taken of each team before the start of the tournament (or later if under time pressure).
 Winners' photos will be circulated to some media outlets.
 Coaches are to notify should any child not be permitted inclusion beforehand
- A pitch coordinator will be assigned to each pitch to record results, keep games on time and ensure team and match officials are designated pitch. Any issues to be directed to the pitch coordinator however the referee's decision is always final
